





Malibu Hotel

Just as the island of Enoshima is a symbol of Kamakura, so Mt. Fuji symbolizes Japan. At Malibu Hotel, which opened in March, guests can enjoy the elegance of those two landmarks in complete privacy. The hotel is located in Riviera Zushi Marina, a marina resort with restaurants located close to Kamakura. It has 11 guestrooms (all suites), each offering views of Mt. SEA AT KAMAKURA

One of the dominant features of Kamakura is its beautiful sea. The water remains shallow far out to sea, and the waves are gentle. The nineteenth-century ukiyo-e artist Hiroshige captured

the view in Sagami Shichirigahama, one of his Thirty-six Views of Mount Fuji series of woodblock prints. The view has been admired since ancient times and been the subject of various artworks.
